

## **10K Logistics Turnaround Team 101**

Please read this carefully for where/when to report for your Saturday team assignment. You will be assisting with the deconstruction of 10K turnaround on First, south of Irwin Drive.

- Please check-in at 7 a.m. on the west side of the stadium (Great West Hall). There you will receive your official volunteer TEAM t-shirt and drawstring backpack. Wear your official shirt. Dress for the weather. Wear supportive comfortable shoes.

- After checking in, report to Irwin Drive and First, at or before 7:30. Irwin Drive is the little road that leads directly into the north end of the stadium. You will be working with Mike Lindemann: Tall guy with blonde hair. Mike and/or Jan Seeley will find you in this area after the 10K runners clear the start area, which is 7:35 a.m.

Here's a link to 10K map. The indicator for Mile 6 on the map is where you will be working. The goal is to change the traffic barriers after runners have past.

1. Set up 10K turnaround after the 10K passes First & Irwin: Place 10K turnaround sign in middle of the street, place cones in a semi-circle to allow runners to go around them.
2. Direct runners around the turnaround back to Irwin Drive.
3. When lead pack of marathon runners arrive, take down the 10K turnaround and direct all remaining 10K finishers to turn LEFT directly onto Irwin Drive from First St.
