# **Airport Welcome Booth**

#### WHERE TO GO

The Welcome Booth table is located inside the terminal at Willard Airport, Savoy. Enter through any of the doors on the east side of the terminal – the table will be set up near the bottom of the stairs.

### **PARKING**

Park in any of the lots east of the terminal. **DO NOT PARK** directly in front of the terminal. Dated parking passes are in the tub of supplies inside the airport. When your shift is over, take **one pass** with the **correct date** and give your parking ticket and pass to the attendant as you leave the parking lot.

### SUPPLIES AND SET UP

A plastic tub of supplies will be located inside the **Information Area** near the bottom of the stairs in the terminal. Access this area through the half-door (without a door knob). Reach over the door and open it from the inside. When you are finished with your shift return the tub to this location.

# Inside the tub are these items (and possibly others!)

- Illinois Marathon Welcome Sign
- Table cloth
- 2018 Race Guides
- Convention Bureau Guides, maps, coupons and other materials
- 2018 Illinois Marathon magnets
- 2018 Finisher medals (**for display ONLY**)
- Volunteer shirts and bags
- Contact info for volunteers
- Coordinator contact info

Back for 2018: The Willard Airport team will be providing a WELCOME T-shirt for arriving guests. Please give each race guests one of these shirts as a gift from Willard.

### RESPONSIBILITIES

Set up the table to display the Christie Clinic Illinois Marathon sign, race guides, visitor guides, maps, magnets, and finisher medals. **Medals are for display only—don't give them away!** 

Wear your volunteer shirt. Greet runners, families and friends coming from flights, answer questions, give out race guides, visitor guides, and magnets. Make yourself comfortable and have fun!

# **AFTER YOUR SHIFT**

Put the finisher medals back in the tub and return it to the Information Area location. Leave a large sign, a few magnets and other materials on the table. Remember to take your Volunteer shirt, Illinois Marathon string bag and parking pass.
