The primary role of the Blue Man Crew is to keep the port-a-potties stocked with toilet paper and direct the participants to find the shortest lines.

Friday night for 5K 6:00-7:45pm (3 volunteers)

Saturday 6:00am-8:00am (6 volunteers)

- 1. Check-in at the Volunteer check-in table inside Gate 24 of Memorial Stadium. This is on the southwest side. There, you will receive your volunteer TEAM t-shirt and swag bag. Wear your TEAM shirt on your outer layer so that you can be recognized as a volunteer.
- 2. Head to your specific post (emailed and assigned to volunteers).
- 3. During your shift, make sure all potties are unlocked when not in use and loaded with toilet paper. Extra toilet paper rolls will be next to each section of toilets.
- 4. Coordinate lines for participants and direct them to the shortest line.
- 5. Enjoy the chaos and enthusiasm at the start of the race!
