

2017 Christie Clinic Illinois Marathon: Memorial Stadium Spectator Guidelines

Friday 5K and Saturday race day parking: The main free parking lots for spectators are in the four State Farm Center parking lots, the Research Park (off of St. Mary's and Oak), and Lot E14 (off of Oak).

- Spectators access the stadium through Door 32 on southwest side or on the east side through Door 23. Please note that entry times are longer at Door 32. **Use Door 23 for speedy entry.**
- Backpacks, bags, coolers, containers, and alcoholic beverages are NOT allowed into Memorial Stadium. Small purses and fanny packs (8.5 x 11) or smaller are allowed, but are subject to inspection.
- Pets are not allowed in the stadium.
- No spectators are allowed on the Memorial Stadium Field. Spectators can cheer on the participants from the east or west stands or the Horseshoe stands.
- No spectators are allowed in the Great West Hall unless you are accompanying a race entrant that is a minor.
- Meet your family after the race in the FAMILY REUNION area in the Horseshoe bleachers (south side). On Saturday, that location will be marked by two huge feather banners labeled MEET ME ZONE. For the 5K, we will use those feather banners on the stadium floor to create a special area where families running the race can reconnect after crossing the finish line.
- Restrooms are located on the east side of Memorial Stadium and in the Horseshoe.
- Starting at 5:30 a.m. on April 22 near the bag drop area, west of the State Farm Center, Einstein Bros. Bagels and Columbia Street Roastery will cohost FREE coffee and bagels.
- The 4th Mile street fest event takes place after the Presence Health 5K on Friday, April 21 on Kirby Avenue between First and Fourth streets, just outside the Stadium. 6:30 to 10:00 p.m.
- Starting at 8 a.m. on Saturday, April 22, the Meijer 27th-Mile Celebrate Victory Bash will kick off in the same location between First and Fourth streets.
