Stadium Clean Up 101

Check-in Procedure

• Please allow time to park (see parking map) and get checked in at Memorial Stadium. Enter on the west side into the Great West Hall through Gate 24 and check in at the Volunteer check-in booth where you'll get your official Team shirt & drawstring backpack. You will also get a stadium staff jacket so you can get onto the stadium floor.

- Please check-in by the beginning of your shift. The coordinators of the stadium clean-up crew are Tom Coleman: (217/714-0944) and Jan Seeley (217/369-8553).
- You will be directed by either Tom Coleman or Jan Seeley to perform various clean-up duties in the Great West Hall and on the stadium floor. When you complete one task, you'll be assigned another.
- Please dress for the weather, as your job is a rain or shine job. Please tune to WIXY 100.3, Mix 94.5, Rewind 92.5, or WIXY Classic 99.1 for any breaking news with the race, regarding weather.

3 Shifts: 8:30 a.m. to noon; 11:00 to 3:00 p.m. and 2:30 to 5:00. 10 volunteers per shift

For those working the Great West Hall (GWH), your job is to cart to the large dumpsters outside the stadium on the southwest corner all the cardboard that is being generated in the food area (pizza boxes, cardboard boxes, etc) as well as empty the trash barrels that will be in the GWH. Put a new trash liner in the trash barrel every time you remove a bag of trash. Extra trash bags will be in W-6 Concession stand in the GWH.

For those working on the Stadium floor, your job is make sure only recyclables (plastic water bottles and Gatorade bottles) are put into the large recycling bins and that Gatorade cups go in the trash barrels. Take full bags of trash to the dumpster outside the Stadium at the southwest side.

Our goal is to leave Memorial Stadium cleaner than we found it.
