



## **Best Spectator Viewing Areas: Half Marathon (first three) and Marathon (all locations)**

All viewing areas are accessible from the beltway [https://illinoismarathon.com/wp-content/uploads/IL\\_Marathon\\_beltway.pdf?x93355](https://illinoismarathon.com/wp-content/uploads/IL_Marathon_beltway.pdf?x93355) . Those viewing areas closest to the beltway are likely to have higher traffic volumes. Spectators should use the public parking areas identified to avoid private parking issues and the possibility of being towed. In some cases, spectators may need to walk a few blocks to reach the route.

### **Mile 4: Prairie Park/Urbana Early Childhood School**

Parking is available at the school, which is accessible from Washington Street.

### **Mile 7: Meijer in Urbana**

Spectators are asked to park away from the store, at the west side of the lot.

### **Mile 11.5: Maryland and Pennsylvania**

Spectators are asked to park in University Lot F-23, which is located at the southwest corner of Lincoln and Florida. Spectators will then need to walk 3 blocks to the north.

### **Mile 14: Main/Church and Neil**

Spectators are asked to park in the city lot located at the southwest corner of Washington and Neil.

### **Mile 21 & 22.8**

Parking is available in the Goodwill/Schnucks parking area. To get to the viewing area, walk west on Curtis Rd. to the corner of Prospect and Curtis (mile 21). Runners will be heading south. You can also see runners heading north on Wesley as they cross Curtis Rd. at mile 22.8.

### **Mile 24.3**

Park at the Shoppes at Knollwood, behind Biaggi's. Walk west to Fox Dr. Runners will be heading north on Fox Drive.

### **Memorial Stadium**

Free parking in the State Farm Center lots and Research Park.
